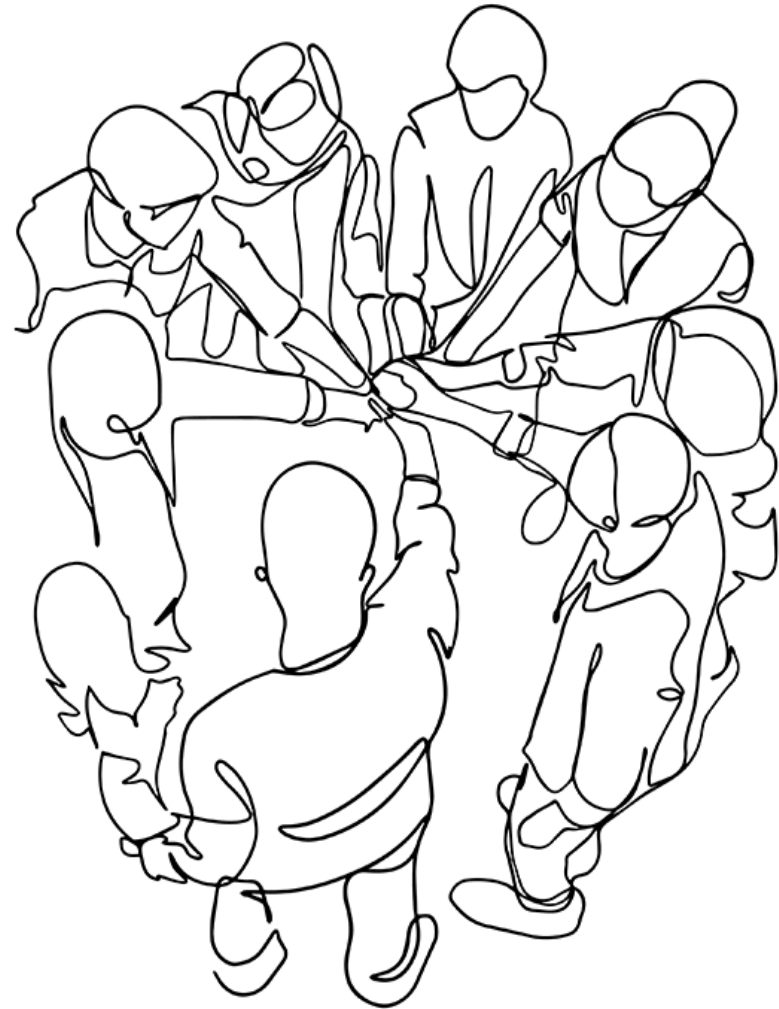
The University operates at the heart of the society to which it belongs.

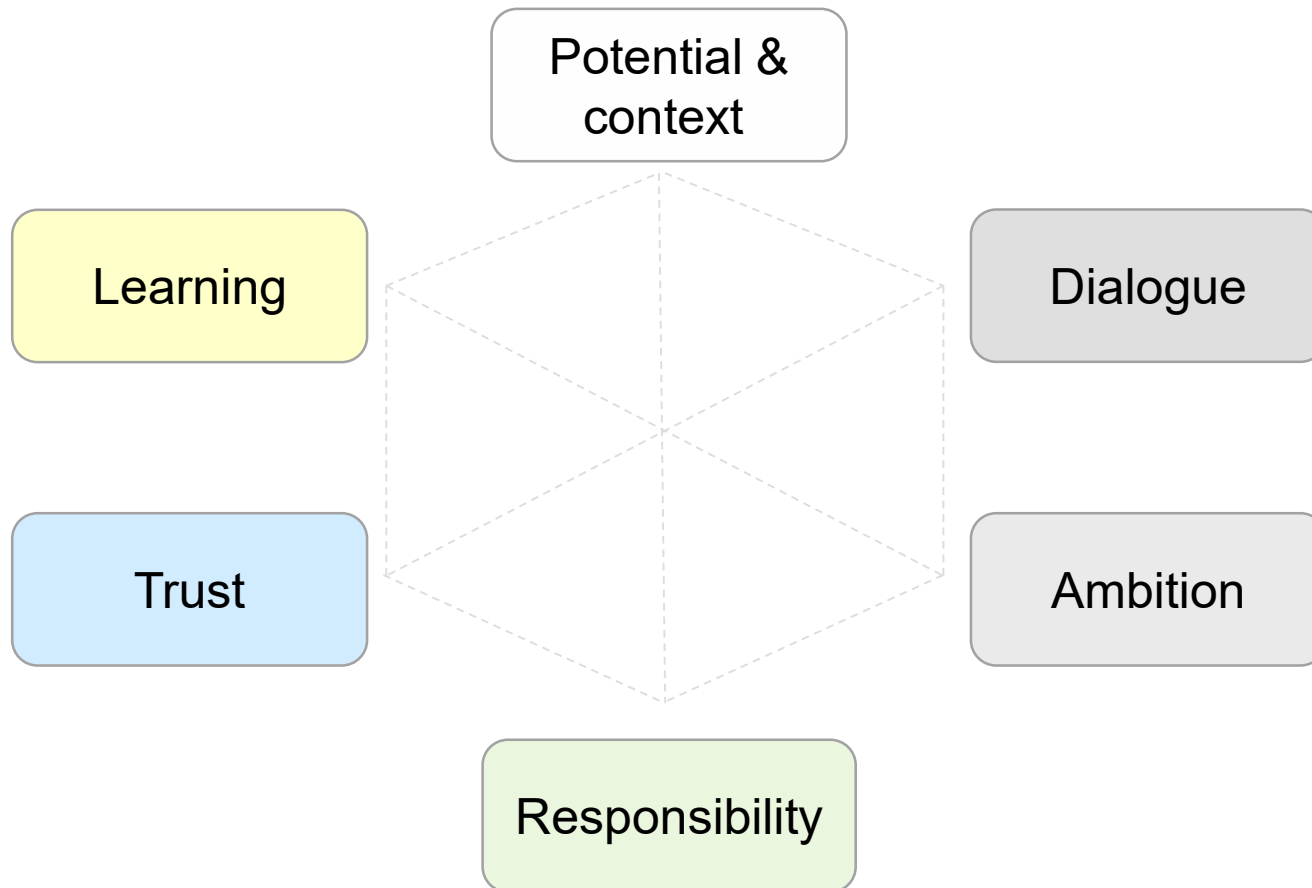
